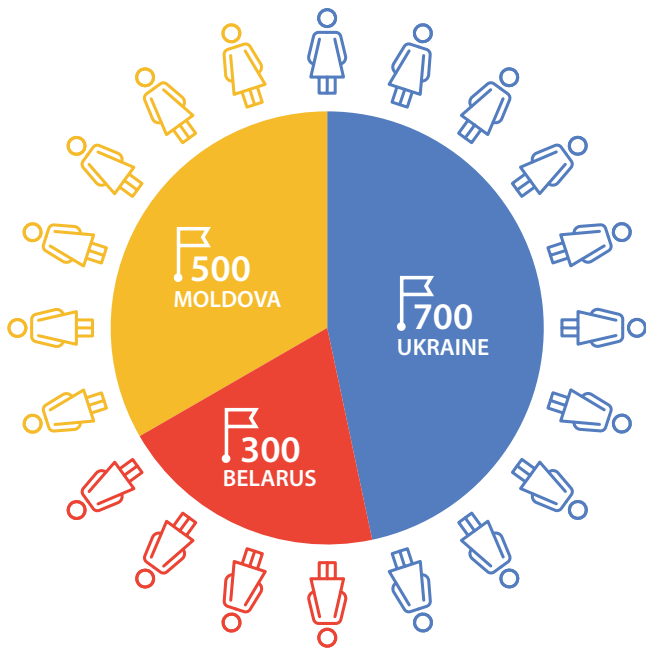
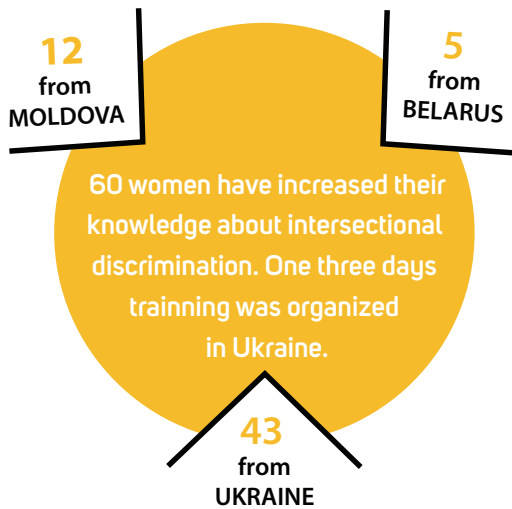


ROMA WOMEN'S POWER 2019

About 1500 Roma women and girls in Ukraine, Belarus and Moldova planned project activities and benefited from them



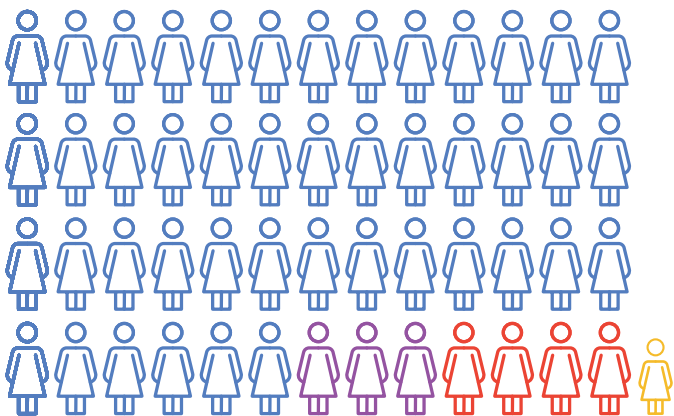
REGIONAL NETWORK OF ROMA WOMEN AND GENDER EQUALITY



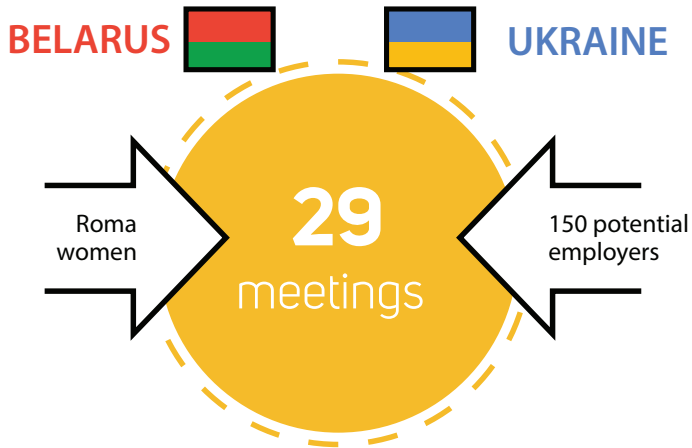
ECONOMIC EMPOWERING

269 Roma women received trainings and consultations on how to find jobs.

150 small businesses and entrepreneurs were participants of meetings of Roma women with potential employers



17 Roma women and **6** girls had internships and **46** women (17%) were employed as a result of project implementation



ADVOCACY ON ROMA RIGHTS AT THE LOCAL, NATIONAL LEVELS AND REGIONALLY

Representatives of municipal and ministerial level authorities have more knowledge about the needs of the Roma women and girls

- 4 educational courses on business and IT profession for Roma girls in Belarus

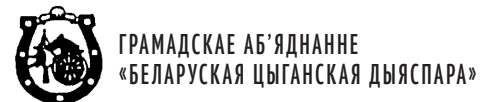

Mapping was conducted in Moldova and covered **476** Roma women from **48** localities of the country
